One signature of 16 pages about the general theme borders.


I represent border between light and dark, between the capability to see and the impossibility of it. It is realized with photographic printing tecnique.

More sketches were realized for this project, for example, in the composition above the phonetic sign is showed overlaped to his normal sequence of letters.
















## **Particolare Universale**

We testified the date, time and georaphical position of each finds. **User's experience and** navigation inside the exhibition rebuilt the terrorial identity.


Parola macchina del pensiero




















### **Taraxacum**


## **Collecting and sharing** memories



## **Playing the Ducal Palace**







When it is completely unfolded only letters and other symbols are recognisible.






























## **Art Inspitarion Encyclopaedia**

Handmade notebooks, realized using printed sheets tests, old fotocopies, packagings, shopping bags








