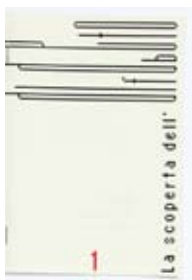

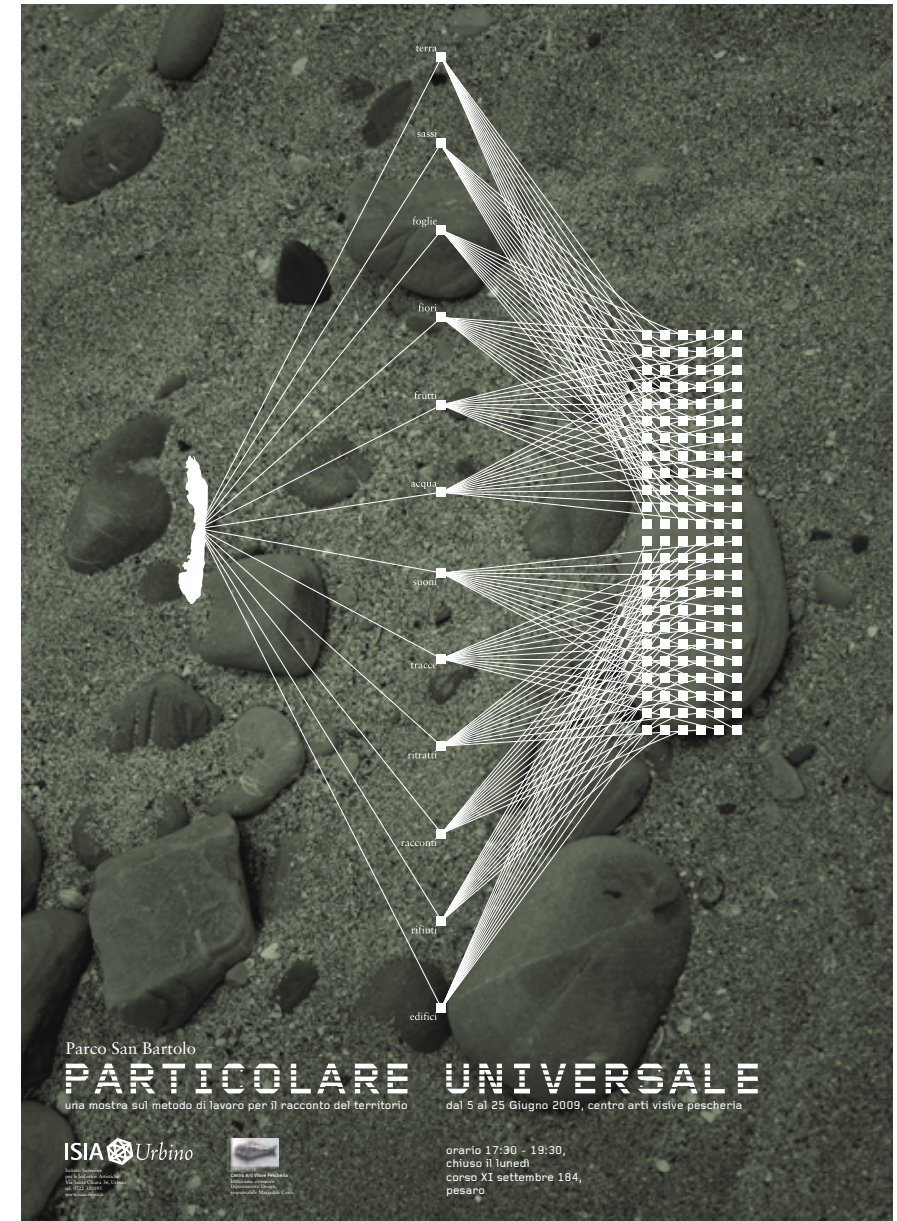
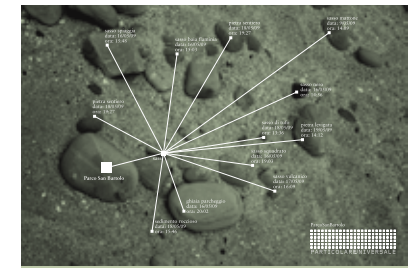

People received a magnetic word and the possibility to use it to write their thoughts in 5 big white pages, getting in touch with other users' thoughts and words.

5 big iron plates, located around a park invited people to compose sentences. The words were selected from some interviews about Olivetti's nostalgia in Ivrea.

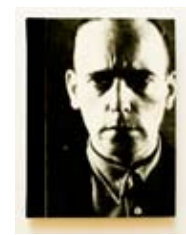


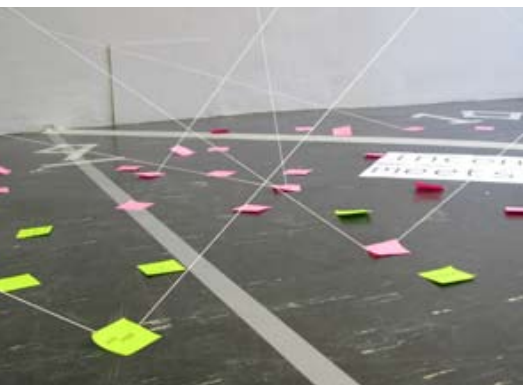

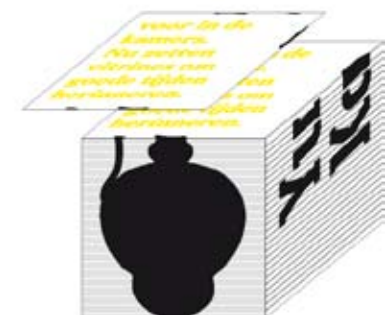
Cutted poster becomes a tool to share objects and their personal stories.

Users could take with them a unique piece of the black object and a part of the big text about memory.

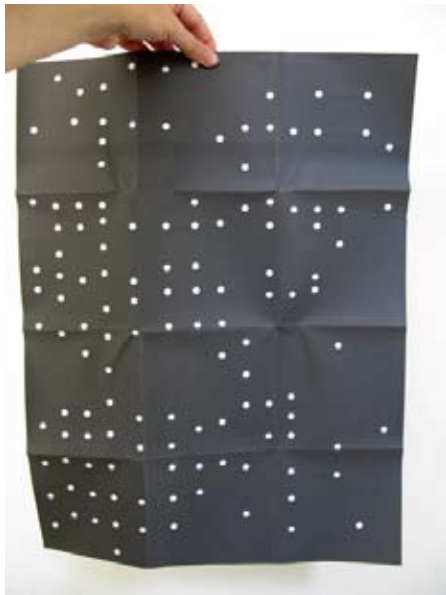




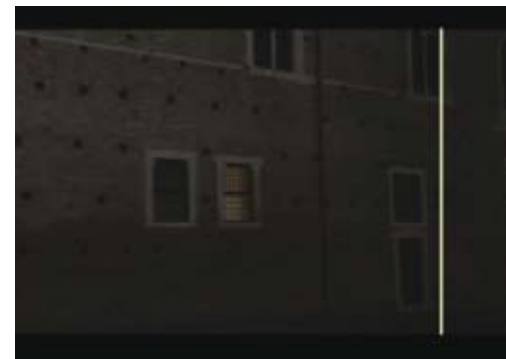
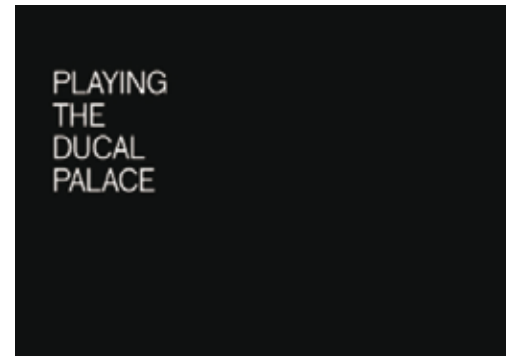
Playing the Ducal Palace

Poster that contains CDrom with the video "Plaing the Ducal Palace", and three audio tracks (facade #1, facade #2, facade #3).

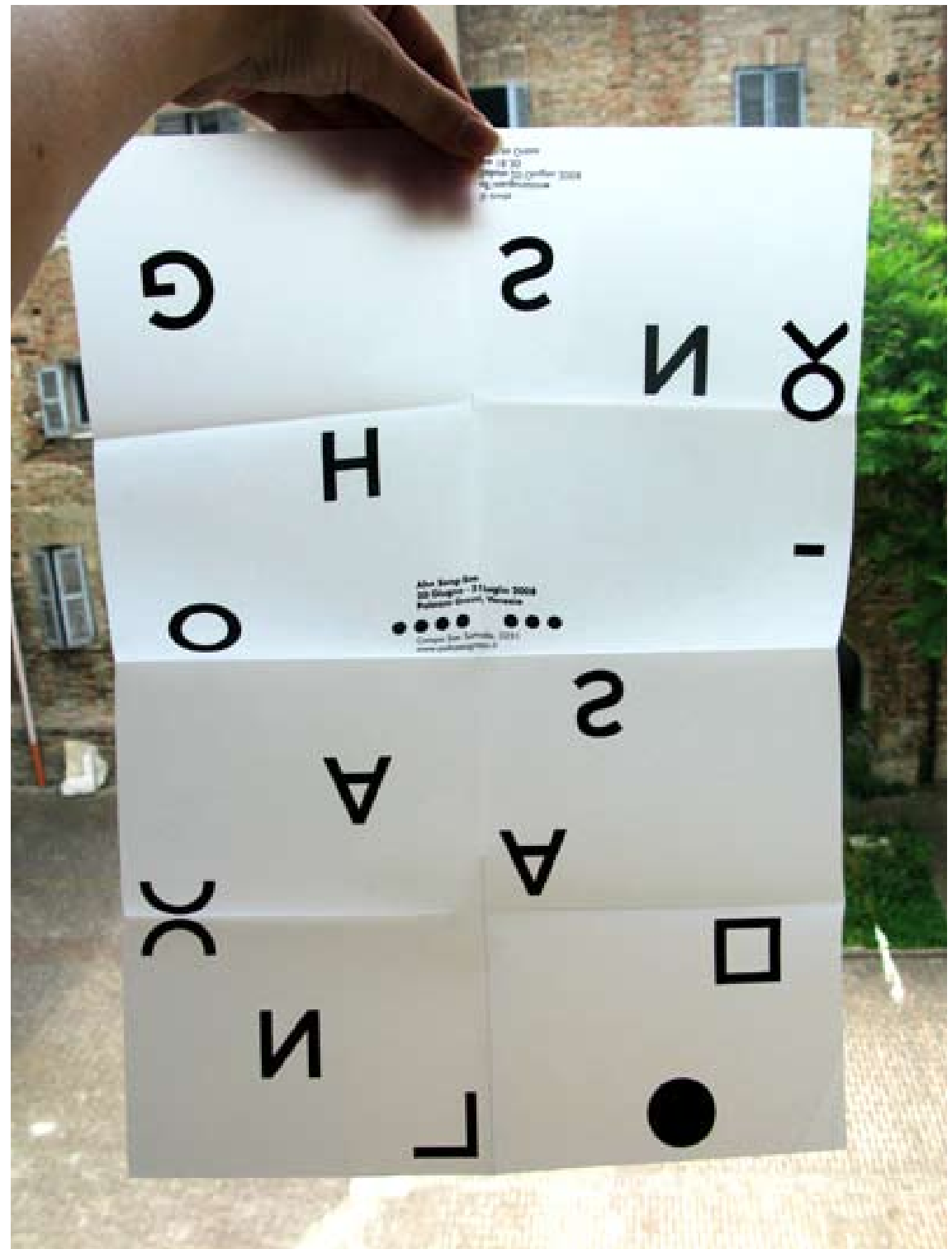

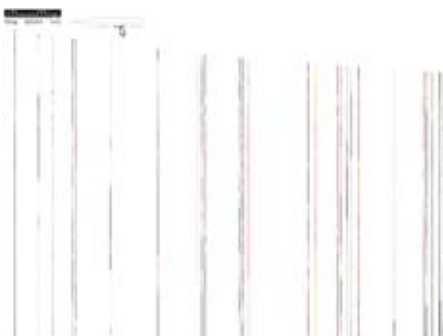
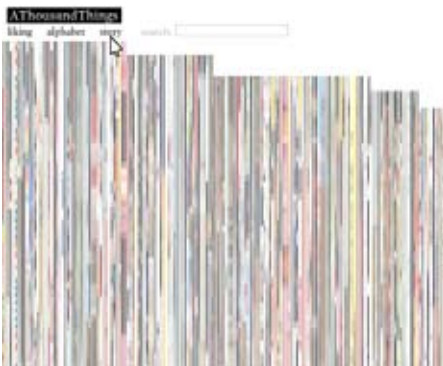
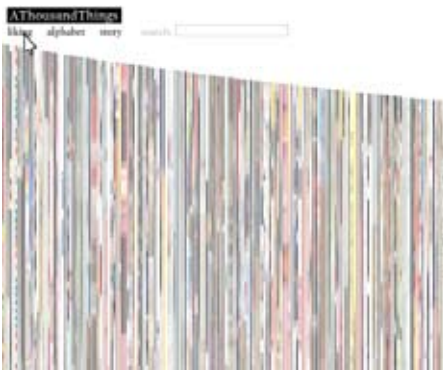


Art Inspitarion Encyclopaedia

This structure allows the user to organize lemmas with different criterias, (alphabetic, cronhological, liking) and to select one word and explore its content at different depths.

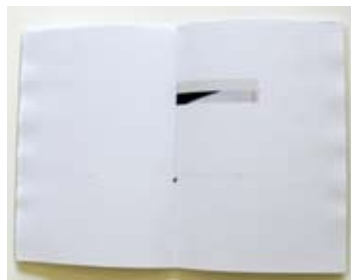
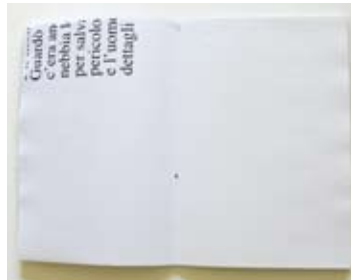
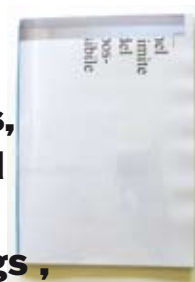
